	• DC Health has moved into a new building on February 26, 2024, the new address is 2201 Shannon Place SE, Washington, DC 20020, the next Optometry board meeting is scheduled on July 18 <sup>th</sup> , 2024, in person and members of the public are invited to attend the in-person board meeting as well.	
	• Mrs. Walker introduced the new Health Licensing Specialist, Ms. Tiguist Zerihun, who is currently assigned to work with the board of Optometry.	
	<ul> <li>The Mayor's Office of Talent and Appointments (MOTA) recruits talented and interested individuals from all eight (8) Wards to serve on District Boards. The Board of Optometry is currently seeking to fill the vacancy for a consumer board member.</li> </ul>

	Mr. Gohil gave an update on the following:	
	• Mr. Ajay Gohil informed the Board Members, Staff, and the Public on the amendments that were forwarded to the committee on health as well as the council to expand the Optometry scope of practice did not get approved.	
	<ul> <li>Mr. Ajay Gohil announced the next ARBO meeting is scheduled for June 16<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup>, 2024 in Nashville, Tennessee and he's looking forward to the new "Board Attorney Panel", which he will present at the conference along with two other attorneys from Oregon and</li> </ul>	



	Tennessee. There are scholarship applications available for anyone who is interested in attending.

	<ul> <li>Dr. Lisa Johnson briefly discussed her attendance at the ARBO meeting in Phoenix, Arizona, she is currently on the committee for the OE Tracker. OE Tracker has implemented new updates scheduled to launch in June to make it easier for Optometrists to upload their continuing education courses.</li> </ul>
	• Dr. Lisa Johnson also requested effective and better instructions for the next renewal cycle in the future.
DISCUSSION	ITEMS
OS-0418-07	<ul> <li>Legislative Updates – Office of Government Relations:</li> <li>Mr. Ajay Gohil provided an update on behalf of Kera Johnson, who wasn't in attendance at the meeting, due to a conference she attended in Nashville, Tennessee.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Health Occupations Revision Act (HORA) Update:</li> <li>DC Health worked on a significant revision of the HORA. This would be the first significant revision in seventeen years.</li> <li>The revised HORA received Mayoral approval and has been introduced in the Council as the <i>Health Occupations Revision General Amendment Act of 2023</i> (B25-0545).</li> <li>This legislation received a hearing on <u>December 7<sup>th</sup></u>. Over 80 witnesses, many of whom were healthcare professionals, signed up to provide testimony. DC Health's Associate Director of Health Professional Licensing Boards provided testimony in support and answered questions from the Council.</li> <li>A mark-up was held on <u>March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024</u>. The legislation then went to the Committee of the Whole where it underwent the First reading and was approved unanimously. It will now go through a Second Reading in early May.</li> <li>Changes:</li> <li>Telehealth: The bill as introduced proposes the first-ever uniform guidelines for telehealth services in the District, including:</li> <li>Allowing for District-licensed professionals to use telehealth as a service modality to treat patients located in the District,</li> </ul>



<ul> <li>Permits a patient-client or patient-provider relationship to be established through telehealth,</li> <li>Requires that health professionals providing telehealth services to register with the District and comply with the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program when prescribing certain medications, and exempts telehealth companies from the Certificate of Need Scope of</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Practice, Licensure, and Registration Updates:</li> <li>The Committee Print removes the proposal in the bill as introduced to expand the scope of practice for optometrists to include the administration of controlled substances and the diagnosis and treatment of glaucoma.</li> <li>Optometrists will continue to serve their patients comprehensively, retaining the ability to prescribe antibiotics, appropriate analgesics, antihistamines, and non-steroidal anti-inflammatories. Will also maintain the ability to initiate glaucoma treatment with consultation from the patient's physician or another appropriate healthcare provider, as well as administer mediation for the emergency treatment of angle closure glaucoma.</li> <li>Reorganization of Health Professional Licensing Boards: Currently oversees 19 Health Professional Boards – this bill is changing that by decreasing the total number of Boards to 15 (merging/consolidating). The Board of Optometry will remain independent.</li> <li>Reasons: Improve administrative efficiency of boards to streamline the application process and address quorum issues and board vacancies.</li> </ul>	
DC Health Fiscal Year 2025 Budget Oversight:	
• DC Health had its Fiscal Year 2025 Budget Oversight hearing in early April. This hearing offered an opportunity for the Committee on Health to review DC Health's proposed budget for the 2025 Fiscal Year.	
• There were two hearings, one on April 10 for public witnesses and one on April 11 <sup>th</sup> for representatives from DC Health, including testimony from the Director of DC Health, Dr. Ayanna Bennett. To watch the hearing, visit this <u>link</u> .
