1. Community College Prep Academy at 3301 Wheeler Rd, SE has received conditional approval from our office to provide training at the BLS level for EMS certification, and EMS continuing education.
2. HIPAA and OSHA training for EMT students has been published to the HSEMA LMS, and is available for consumption. Links to be distributed with meeting minutes.
3. DC EMS eConference is set for 11/2 and 11/3. Just a reminder to push the flyer out to both current students and graduates.
4. Upcoming whiteboard session is to be held at DC Health on 11/8 regarding planning for student minimum competencies for EMT and AEMT. Program Directors or their designees are invited to attend. RSVP to EMS.HEPRA@dc.gov
5. AMR is working with NASEME for a 2024 Level 1 Instructor Course in DC. Dates to be distributed as soon as secured.
6. Review of student feedback for the “DC Health Day” requirement instituted in early 2022. Students are identifying significant gaps in their own knowledge in learning styles, best practices in approaching testing, and executive function skills. DC Health is planning to expand content development to help full this gap for DC EMS students.
7. As the scope of practice and pilot programs approach completion, opportunities/needs will increase for EMS agencies to partner with educational institutes to provide training. Expect increased needs for partnerships in the near future.
