	BOARD ACTION: The board is to continue their discussion on Section 6211,	
	Practice of Nursing Home Administration by Student and Graduate.	
	Background: The Board had some issues regarding the regulations, Section	
	6211.2(b), which allows student to practice as student administrator, without	
	fulfillment of education requirements, as long as the student submits a letter	
	from his/her educational institution. Attorney Vongjaroenrat recommended that	
	the Board requires that the University participates in the education components	
	and evaluation of the program in connection with the supervisor. In addition,	
	AAG Vongjaroenrat recommended that the supervisor must also appear before	
	the Board and explain the benefits of this AIT experience for the student.
