Ebola Outbreak

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recently reported confirmed cases of Ebola virus disease (EVD) in the Uganda caused by the Sudan virus (species Sudan ebolavirus). While no suspected, probable, or confirmed cases related to this outbreak have been reported in the United States or the District of Columbia, the CDC and Department of Homeland Security are routing U.S. bound air passengers who have been to Uganda in the prior 21 days to one of five U.S. airports for entry health screening.

	Avian Influenza	
	Dr. Vito DelVento reported via email on October 26, 2022 about the first confirmed case of a dead bird harboring Avian Influenza. The case has been reported by the National Zoo. Dr. DelVento met with the veterinary team at the National Zoo on October 25, 2022 to further discuss concerns and quarantine protocols. The cause of death of the bird was blunt trauma and upon necropsy Avian Influenza detected as an incidental finding.

The new Veterinary Technician and Euthanasia Technicians regulations became effective Friday, August 6, 2021. At this time, the DC Department of Health will not be issuing registrations until the process is in place.





	The Department of Health is currently creating the platform by which individuals can submit an application for registration as either a Veterinary Technician or a Veterinary Euthanasia Technician. Once the platform is available, there will be a grace period for which individuals will need to come into full compliance.
