



Need Dental Care?

Free cleanings, fillings, extractions and limited treatment partials will be offered at the American Dental Association's Mission of Mercy.

Patients will be seen on a first-come, first-served basis. Our patient quota is typically reached by noon, so come early! All work is provided by approximately 1,000 volunteer dental professionals and community helpers.

Adults and children with limited financial resources or who are otherwise unable to visit a dental office and who do not have a medically compromising condition that prohibits safely receiving care are welcome.

Note: Photo identification, social security number or other personal ID/documentation is NOT required. Interpreters will be available to assist patients.

Please do NOT wait for the ADA Mission of Mercy to seek care for dental pain, as this could signify a serious condition. If dental pain is severe and accompanied by a fever or swelling, go to a hospital emergency room immediately!
