	 There would be restrictions, including that the Board Chair and Consumer Members would continue to need to be District residents 		
	Consumer Members would continue to need to be District residents		
	and no more than 50% of the Board could be made up of non- District residents.		
	 This bill received a hearing on <u>July 13, 2023</u>. DC Health testified during this 		
	hearing and expressed support for the need for innovative solutions to fill		
	board vacancies and offered some changes to the bill. It will likely receive a		
	markup in September.		
	Health Professional Compact Bills:		
	Councilmember Gray has introduced bills that would have the District join two		
	health professional licensing compacts:		
	• The Occupational Therapy Licensure Compact Approval Act of 2023 (B25-		
	0286) would have the District join the Occupational Therapy Licensure		
	Compact and applies to Occupational Therapists and Occupational		
	Therapy Assistants. The compact is not operational but is scheduled to		
	 start accepting applications in mid-2024. DC Health is evaluating these bills and here will likely be hearings this fall.
