ITEM	DISCUSSION
Call to Order	Jenné M. called the meeting to order at 5:10 pm, followed by a moment of silence and introductions.
Review and Adoption of the Agenda	With no corrections or additions to the CEEC Agenda for the October 17, 2024 noted, Jenné assumed the motion to adopt the agenda as presented.
Review and Approval of the Minutes	With no corrections or additions to the CEEC Meeting Minutes for September 19, 2024 noted, Jenné assumed the motion to approve the minutes as presented.
Workplan 2024 Discussion	<p>The CEEC meeting focused on planning the 2025 Protocol Summit, centered on HIV and aging, proposed for April 2025. The committee suggested the Barbara Jordan Conference Center as the venue and discussed other topics related to aging. Some of the suggestions were:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • social drivers of health among immigrant and Muslim populations • the expansion of PrEP • intersectionality of sexual health and mental health from both prevention and treatment • HIV and aging and HIV and stability • polypharmacy and aging • chronic disease and aging • prevention research that is forthcoming <p>Rodney L. reported that he has resources and expert presenters who can assist with training relating to aging. One of his colleagues, Dorcas Baker, has conducted lots of research on the subject and has worked with Julie Orban, Chair of the HAHSTA Committee on Aging. Rodney also has connections with Lorraine Bullock and Gordan at the Barbara Jordan Center and agreed to contact the center for available dates in April. Rodney via AETC can also support food purchases for the summit.</p> <p>It was noted that some of the suggested topics could be subtopics under a “Special Populations” umbrella. Jenné suggested polling the COHAH General Body for additional topics or suggestions. She also suggested breaking the summit out over a series of two to three parts to enable a deeper dive into the different subtopics.</p>
Other Business	Rodney asked if the COHAH had discussions about youth engagement in DC, specifically around HIV prevention and testing, different resources, and the sharing of information with different providers. He asked if there is a way to develop a collaborative approach or networking space with the different agencies to share information and is the CEEC meeting where discussions about those resources can be held to bridge the gap when it comes to communication dissemination. Lamont responded that HAHSTA has a youth
