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	DC Health Fiscal Year 2025 Budget Oversight
	<ul> <li>DC Health will have its Fiscal Year 2025 Budget Oversight hearing in early April. This hearing offers an opportunity for the Committee on Health to review DC Health's proposed budget for the 2025 Fiscal Year.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>You can find information about the proposed Fiscal Year 2025 budget <u>here</u>.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>There will be two hearings, one on April 10th for public witnesses and one on April 11th for representatives from DC Health.</li> </ul>
	Dental Specialties Licensure and Scope of Practice Amendment Act of 2023
	<ul> <li>Following efforts by the Board of Dentistry, Chairman Mendelson (at the request of Mayor Bowser) introduced the <i>Dental Specialties Licensure and Scope of Practice Amendment Act of 2023</i> (<u>B25-0632</u>) on December 13, 2023.</li> <li>The bill expands the scope of practice for dentists, including adding the ability to provide immunizations. It establishes a new license for those seeking to practice oral and maxillofacial surgery. Finally, it closes a loophole to ensure non-licensed professionals are not involved in the operations or management of a dental practice.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>This legislation has not received a hearing. It was not incorporated into the Health Occupations Revision General Amendment Act of 2023 (<u>B25-0545</u>) and will therefore need one to proceed.</li> </ul>
	Health Occupations Revision Act (HORA) Update:
	<ul> <li>DC Health worked on a significant revision of the HORA. This would be the first significant revision in seventeen years.</li> <li>The revised HORA received Mayoral approval and has been introduced in the</li> </ul>
	Council as the <i>Health Occupations Revision General Amendment Act of 2023</i> ( <u>B25-0545</u> ).
	<ul> <li>This legislation received a hearing on <u>December 7th</u>. Over 80 witnesses, many of whom were healthcare professionals, signed up to provide testimony. DC Health's Associate Director of Health Professional Licensing Boards provided testimony in support and answered questions from the Council.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>DC Health has been working on the Committee on Health following that hearing. A mark-up was held on <u>March 21st, 2024</u>. The legislation was passed unanimously by the Committee of the Whole on First Reading on April 2nd. It is scheduled for a Second Reading on May 7<sup>th</sup>.</li> </ul>
	<b>Ms. Carla Williams</b> added to Mr. Lieb's report by offering more clarity on what DC Council is working on and how it differs from what the Board is doing, specifically in reference to the Dental Specialties Licensure and Scope of Practice Amendment Act, the Dental Assistant Level III, and the process of bills in general moving through the legislative process.
	<b>Ms. Terry Reeves</b> asked a question in regard to if there will be language that address how the billing will be handled if the dental hygienist are providing some services. Ms. Williams answered that the Board has no jurisdiction over how the billing is done. Mr. Lieb stated that billing is not in this legislation's purview. But he also offered that there is language on this particular issue already listed that can be found at this link <u>here</u> .
