Recruitment and retention are an ongoing challenge for the DC WIC Program. This

is partially related to the salary that can be offered, but the challenge also stems

from a lack of diverse applicants. The DC WIC Program has two levels of

nutritionist positions: The Competent Professional Authority (CPA) and the

Competent Paraprofessional Authority (CPPA). CPAs must be licensed in DC and

can have a variety of backgrounds, including CNS certification or RD certification.

CPPAs minimum qualification is a high school degree and 1 year WIC experience,

however, most of DC WIC's CPPAs have a bachelor's degree in nutrition, public

health, or a related field. CPPAs are not licensed, and do not see clients
