# EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ENDORSEMENT APPLICATION (MFT)

# **Board Action:**

To discuss whether to adopt into policy for MFT applicants who have already taken and passed the nation exam in other jurisdiction in lieu of the AMFRTB National Exams for licensure by endorsement to the District of Columbia. Also, to discuss whether to adopt into policy whether to contact AMFTRB to enquire which other States have Exams that are comparable or equivalent to the AMFTRB National Exams for licensure in DC.

# Background:

The current regulation under section 7706 indicates the waiver of examination and educational requirements for licensure. Certain applicants have been licensed in other for a longer duration. For example, over 10 years, and have the required practical experience most often are required to take the AMFTRB National Exams prior to licensure by endorsement in DC. Some states do have the examination





waiver requirements for applicants applying by reciprocity provided they might have taken a state exam (example: California State Exams) which might be comparable to the National Exams. The Board to review section 7706 of the current regulations to identify if the requirements could be streamlined to facilitate the administrative, review, and approval process of applicants who fall under this category.

# **Supervised Practice Form**

## **Update:**

# Background:

A supervised practice form is listed under section 9105.8 regarding the supervised experience requirement which requires the supervisor(s) to submit the completed form to the Board. The purpose of the graduate professional counseling license is to allow individual to practice under supervision of a licensed professional counselor. However, the regulations also indicate a supervisor, or supervisee shall submit a supervised practice form within 2 weeks of commencing supervision. In March 2022, the Board tabled to address the supervised practice form for the subcommittee.
