Background: Board Attorney, Panravee Vongjaroenrat, informed the Board that the Director of DC Health, Dr. Nesbitt, will be implementing a public health priorities continuing education requirement. The Director has determined that all health professional licensees in the District will be required to take ten (10) percent of their continuing education in public health priorities that will be determined by the Department.
