	Jenné indicated that in the past week the committee launched the website and social media pages to start collecting more names and places for the on- going DMV History project. She described the project as a collaboration with COHAH, CEEC, the Montgomery County Department of Health and Intersectionality Research at George Washington University and others. The goal is to collect some oral narratives as well as other historical information about different people and places in the DMV and surrounding counties in Virginia and Maryland that were important to the HIV movement. One of the culminating goals is to hallmark historical markers of places that have had a great impact on the movement.

It was suggested to have an in-person training on Thursday April 14, 2022 at 6:00pm (venue to be determined) and a virtual training during the CEEC meeting on April 21, 2022. Direct it to the Executive Directors or Case Managers (i.e., Whitman Walker, SLK, etc.) to distribute during their support service groups Create something that all the agencies can put on their social media Leverage POWAB - to contact institutions of faith that have HIV ministries.
