Youth Summit Update	Alan J. reported on the Youth Services Coalition meeting that was held today to get a sense of the World AIDS Day activities anticipated from other organizations. Another group, the Youth Services Team, met yesterday and discussed if time around World AIDS Day would be a good time to engage young people for a testing and engagement event. Time around Valentine Day was also discussed considering the youth event funds will be available until then. A work plan must be developed, and updates will be given once a more formalized plan is in place.
