Review and Approval of the Minutes

Jenné assumed the motion to approve the meeting minutes for September 15, 2022. There were no corrections to the minutes. The minutes were approved as presented.

Jed B. indicated that the summit will be held on November 16, 2022, 9am-4pm at the Human Rights Campaign (HRC) located at 1640 Rhode Island Avenue, Washington, DC.

Jed created an invitation flyer and a rsvp form for tracking. He has also conducted a few soft invites to CCI, a health center in Silver Spring and Planned Parenthood who have both confirmed their attendance. Lamont C. suggested reaching out to Ken Pettigrew at Health HIV to get his opinion and use as a resource. He further suggested to ask Anthony G. to reach out to Demarc Hickson at UHU for a quicker response. Lamont will help with inviting the appropriate government departments and agencies.
