Non-Approved Nursing Education Institutions

In accordance with Title 17 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, specifically for Registered Nurses (RN) 17 DCMR §§ 5402-5403, and Chapter 56, and for Licensed Practical Nurses (LPN) 17 DCMR §§ 5502-5503, and Chapter 56, all applicants for licensure as an RN or LPN must have completed satisfactorily and met all requirements for a diploma or degree from either: (1) An education program approved by the Board (applicable to in-state programs); or (2) An education program in any other state or country that the Board finds substantially equivalent to the education program in the District of Columbia at the time of the applicant's graduation. The following Nursing Education Programs have NOT met the requirements to be substantially equivalent. Consequently, applicants who attended a PN/RN nursing education program at any of the following nursing programs will not meet minimum qualifications for licensure as a LPN/RN in the District of Columbia.
