

## Division of Medical Marijuana and Integrative Therapy Ward 7 & Ward 8 Dispensary Update

DC Health has calculated provisional scores for all Ward 7 and Ward 8 applications. Applicants, the public and Advisory Neighborhood Commissions (ANC) in the affected wards were notified on March 28, 2018. The ANCs submitted comments to DC Health on May 3, 2018.

- A six (6) member review panel comprised of representatives from DC Health, Department of Energy and Environment, Office of the Attorney General, Protective Services Division, Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs, and a consumer representative shall have thirty (30) days to evaluate and score the ANC comments.<sup>1</sup>
- The panel shall prepare a report of its final proposed selections and then submit it to the Director of DC Health.<sup>2</sup>
- Within sixty (60) days of receiving the final proposed selections from the panel, the Director shall notify the applicant and the ANCs located in the affected ward of the approval or denial of the application.<sup>3</sup>
- An applicant that has been deemed eligible for a dispensary registration shall complete the steps to obtain a registration and open for business within one hundred twenty (120) days from the date of receipt of the notice of selection.<sup>4</sup>
