| Call to Order | Meeting called to order at 3:07 pm by Lenora M. followed by a moment of silence. Attendees introduced themselves. | | | |
| Review and Approval of the Agenda | Traci D. motioned to approve the January 21,2018 Agenda. The motion was seconded by Dennis M. The motion passed unanimously. | | | |
| Review and Approval of the Minutes | Dennis motioned to approve the December 17, 2019 Minutes. Traci seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. | | | |
| Needs Assessment Discussion | Lamont C. noted that the survey was finalized at the last meeting but the committee should discuss how to market the survey and the role of DIS. Leah V.noted that a meeting is scheduled with Kaleef M., Toni Fleming, and herself to discuss how the survey could possibly be integrated with the DIS work. | | | |



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Depending on how the meeting goes, whatever is agreed upon would then have to be added to the IRB submission. Leah stated that the next IRB submission would be February 5, 2020. She also noted that she needed to understand how the committee is defining "out of care" because this needs to be added to the IRB submission. DeMarc H. noted that they are going with the HRSA definition of "out of care". Lenora asked if there needed to be some sort of special meeting after their meeting with Toni, but before the IRB submission? Lamont suggested that instead of a special meeting, if necessary, Kaleef could debrief DeMarc at the Executive Committee meeting.

Dennis suggested involving Community Based Organizations. Lamont noted that the Program Officers would ensure that CBOs were aware of the survey. He also noted that CMOC would also be utilized to help get the word out. David H. asked how could they reach out to organizations that do not receive funding. Lamont noted that over 60 providers receive funding, so they would be the primary sources of reaching the population. He also noted that the population is very difficult to reach so utilizing other, cost-effective, methods of outreach would be a good part of reaching the population. Traci asked about using the Health and Wellness Center. Lamont and Leah noted that if DIS is able to assist, they already spend a good portion of their time at the Health and Wellness Center. Leah noted that if anyone has connections to organizations that may have access to this population they should let the committee know so they can reach out to them. Lenora suggested posting this information on BaseCamp.

ANNOUNCEMENTS/OTHER DISCUSSION

Leah stated that the '1906' committee is having various sessions for the community. She asked members to share any ideas of how they think COHAH can stay involved. There is a draft document that will be discussed, and the final draft is expected to be ready by June 2020.
