

The basis of the contemplated action is certain information received by the agency which, if proven to be true, justifies taking the proposed action pursuant to D.C. Code § 3-1205.15.

The charge upon which the summary suspension is based is set forth below.


Charge I: **Your license to practice medicine was suspended in another jurisdiction and the license has not been reinstated, for which the Board can take summary action pursuant to D.C. Code § 3-1205.15(a)(1)(A).**

On January 3, 2019, the Maryland State Board of Physicians entered an order suspending your license to practice medicine in Maryland. To date, your license in Maryland has not been reinstated.

A request for a hearing will not stay this summary suspension. Please note that under 17 DCMR § 4103.2, your failure to appear at the time and place set for the hearing, either in person or through counsel, or both, will not preclude the administrative law judge from proceeding in this matter.
