Call to Order	Meeting called to order at 3:05 pm by Lamont C. followed by a moment of silence. Attendees introduced themselves.



Review and Approval of the Agenda	Lamont assumed the motion to adopt the meeting agenda for the June 20, 2023, REC meeting. There were no modifications to the agenda. The agenda was approved as presented.
Review and Approval of the Minutes	The meeting minutes for May 16, 2023, were reviewed and accepted with no modifications.

Needs Assessment Discussion	Julie O. provided progress updates on the Consumer Needs Assessment. A fourth and final reminder was sent out to sub-recipients on May 31st. Another graduate student intern was onboarded on June 5th. The student's information has been submitted to the IRB and she will be placed at AHF in Prince George's County, MD. Data collection efforts are continuing until June 30th. There are approximately 373 usable survey responses. The survey response goals for DC and Virginia have been met. The priority is to increase responses in Maryland by about 40% or 50 additional surveys. Julie has plans to connect with Melvin C. in Montgomery County, MD to discuss increasing responses from the Dennis Avenue Health Center. There is a need for one additional response in West Virginia to meet the goal of four completed surveys. Julie noted that currently, only one person can pull data reports in Salesforce. She is pulling reports on a weekly basis and sharing them with Alan J. The hope is that there will be no further issues with pulling data during the last two weeks of data collection. An intern will be on site in Montgomery County, MD for data collection during Pride in the Plaza. Along with data collection, the graduate student interns will assist with data analysis, data visualization, and working on a data presentation. They will also be assisting with the final report that must be submitted to the IRB. The tentative plan is for the students to present to the REC and COHAH General Body in July.
