Call to Order	Meeting called to order at 3:06 pm by Lamont C. followed by a moment of silence. Attendees introduced themselves.

Integrated Planning	Lamont provided an update on the Integrated Planning process. DC Health submitted the plan last Friday. Lamont noted that Julie stepped right into the HIV Services Planner role and was a key contributor to the updated Integrated Plan. The new five-year plan is a working document that will be updated as needed.  Ashley noted that the Virginia Integrated Plan was also submitted on Friday. Ashley is looking forward to work collaboratively with DC Health to meet the aligned goals in both jurisdictions. Lamont echoed her sentiments and looks
	Furthermore, the committee is hoping to move forward with acquiring Qualtrics for future data collection needs. Greg D. believes that the data collected in the 153 surveys will be useful data and serve as a foundation for future iterations. He also noted that the ISC Equity Position Paper could help inform the smaller needs assessments noted above.  Ashley Y. is planning to roll out a needs assessment in Virginia during the month of February and will share out EMA findings with REC.

The survey data collection is still a work in progress with a plan for smaller needs assessments in the future.
