Call to Order	Meeting called to order at 3:05 pm by Lamont C. followed by a moment of silence. Attendees introduced themselves.



Review and Approval of the Agenda	2023, REC meeting. There were no modifications to the agenda. The agend was approved as presented.		
Review and Approval of the Minutes	The meeting minutes for April 18, 2023, were reviewed and accepted with no modifications.		
Needs Assessment Discussion	Alan J. provided an update on the Salesforce platform. Alan pulled a report, and it seems like there are missing survey submissions. When looking at the report, there is data from the end of April and a gap until mid-May. During that period, students were in the field collecting survey submissions. In addition, the Accenture team is still working on the unresolved trouble ticket created last month. Julie O. noted that she has also been in communication with Salesforce with hopes that they can find a resolution that the contractor has not been able to. Julie also provided progress updates on the Consumer Needs Assessment. Students are currently placed at a site in Virginia and a site in Montgomery County, MD. Julie and the graduate student interns are currently taking Tableau trainings. The current plan is for the students to assist with data analysis and prepare a presentation for the July REC Meeting. Julie also noted that a 3 rd needs assessment reminder email went out to providers on May 4 th . Graduate student intern, Mmabuese I. shared positive feedback on the three needs assessment surveys that she collected last week in Montgomery County. Julie also shared that the Virginia sub-site had sixteen clients complete the Consumer Needs Assessment as a facilitator went through the survey. Taking those submissions into account, she is hopeful that all submissions will be reflected in the data. Julie is hoping to onboard two additional graduate student interns but notes that the HR process has been delayed. Clover B. has been looped in on this experience and the impact of the delays.		
Other Business	Lamont asked the REC Committee to share their meeting preferences with the options including virtual, hybrid, or in-person. The committee members selected virtual or hybrid meetings for now with an interest in having the General Body Meeting in-person.		
	Lamont mentioned the Quality Committee that the Care Team is establishing for those using Ryan White services per HRSA requirement. The committee would meet once a month to review documents and quality management work		



	going on a HAHSTA. Lamont will email more information and connect those interested in the group to Jose H.		
Future Agenda Items	None noted.		
ANNOUNCEMENTS/ OTHER DISCUSSION	Ashley Y. shared that Virginia released their needs assessment this year for PLWH. The needs assessment is virtual and available in English and Spanish. The survey is set to close on June 2, 2023. Ashley will share the report and any DC or Maryland data with COHAH once the data is analyzed.
