Licensed Pool & Spa Barrier Assessment Checklist

Public Outdoor Pool/Spa Barriers

- Barrier Height: minimum 72" high
- Door Access: open away from the pool, self-closing, self-latching with the release mechanism a minimum of 54" from the floor
- Gate Type: open away from the pool area, self-closing, self-latching, lockable
- □ Latch Height:
 - □ <u>Non-pool side</u>: minimum 54" from the bottom of the gate
 - □ Pool side: 3" from the top of the gate
- Latch Area: no opening greater than ½" within 18" of the latch
- Ground Clearance:
 - Solid Ground: no more than 4" (ex. concrete)
 - □ <u>Non-solid Ground</u>: no more than 2" (ex. grass, gravel, etc.)
- □ <u>Horizontal Members</u>:
 - \Box <u>45" apart or greater</u>: vertical member spacing maximum of 4 inches with cutouts not exceeding 1³/₄"
- Barrier Types:
 - \Box <u>Chain Link</u>: maximum mesh size 1¹/₄" or 1³/₄" if fastened slats present
 - □ <u>Latticework</u>: maximum opening size of 1¾"
 - Solid Wall: no indentations or protrusions excluding normal construction
 - Screened: lower 36" to be hardened

Semi-Public Pool/Spa Barriers (Hotel/Motel/Apartment/Condominium)

- Barrier Height: minimum 48" high
- Door Access: open away from the pool, self-closing, self-latching with the release mechanism a minimum of 54" from the floor
- Gate Type: open away from the pool area, self-closing, self-latching, lockable
- □ Latch Height:
 - □ <u>Non-pool side</u>: minimum 54" from the bottom of the gate
 - Device: 3" from the top of the gate
- Latch Area: no opening greater than ¹/₂" within 18" of the latch
- Ground Clearance:
 - □ <u>Solid Ground</u>: no more than 4" (ex. concrete)
 - □ <u>Non-solid Ground</u>: no more than 2" (ex. grass, gravel, etc.)
- □ <u>Horizontal Members</u>:
 - □ <u>45" apart or greater</u>: vertical member spacing maximum of 4 inches with cutouts not exceeding 1³⁄₄"
- □ <u>Barrier Types</u>:
 - □ <u>Chain Link</u>: maximum mesh size 1¼" or 1¾" if fastened slats present
 - □ <u>Latticework</u>: maximum opening size of 1¾"
- Solid Wall: no indentations or protrusions excluding normal construction
 - □ <u>Screened</u>: lower 36" to be hardened

Above Ground Pools

- Barrier: Must meet the appropriate requirement for either public or semi-public
- Pool Wall: May be part of the barrier
- Ladders: Must be securable, lockable, removable, or enclosed by the barrier

Safety Covers

Covers: must meet performance standards as set by the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) in Standard F1346-91, Standard Performance Specification for Safety Covers and Labeling Requirements for All Covers for Swimming Pools, Spas and Hot Tubs.
