The District of Columbia Municipal Regulations for Radiation Protection require that all companies or persons who calibrate radiation-producing equipment or provide radiation protection and/or health physics consultations be registered with the Department of Health.

The District of Columbia Department of Health's Radiation Protection Division is the designated Office responsible for implementing and enforcing the District's Radiation Protection Regulations. In order to insure that all applicable persons are in conformance with the licensure requirements, we have enclosed an application for registration. Please return the completed application. An annual fee of **One Hundred Dollars** (\$100.00) in the form of a **check** or **money order** made payable to the **D.C. Treasurer** is also required. In addition, please provide a description of your educational background and a list of any professional organization of which you are a member.
