### **DETERMINATION FOR AUDIOLOGY SERVICES**

#### **Board Action:**

The Board is to review the request from Academy of Doctors of Audiology in regard to determination of the audiology services.

# **Background:**

The Academy of Doctors of Audiology (ADA) represents audiologists across the United States. ADA is seeking a written decision from the Board on whether the following services and health screenings are included in the scope of practice for licensed audiologists in the District of Columbia:

- 1. Medical diagnosis of auditory, communication, tinnitus, and vestibular disorders.
- 2. Evaluation and management of auditory, communication, tinnitus, and vestibular disorders.
- 3. Cerumen removal.
- 4. Intraoperative monitoring.
- 5. Cognitive behavioral therapy, specific to an auditory and/or tinnitus rehabilitation/habilitation program.
- 6. Postural blood pressure measurement.
- 7. Telehealth.
- 8. Depression screening using a validated screening tool and referral/plan of care, as warranted.





- 9. Cognitive screening using a validated screening tool and associated referral/plan of care, as warranted.
- 10. Dexterity screening using a validated screening tool and associated referral/plan of care, as warranted.
- 11. Vision screening using a validated screening tool and associated referral/plan of care, as warranted.
- 12. Speech-language screening using a validated screening tool and associated referral/plan of care, as warranted.
