EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

- Covid-19 Vaccine Update

BOARD ATTORNEY'S REPORT

- Ajay Gohil, Board Attorney provided updates on the following items:
 - <u>Criminal Background Check (CBC):</u> DC Council passed statue which became effective on September 21, 2022, regarding the criminal background check review.
 - The CBC review can now be completed with the licensure application review.
 - ii. The Board can review crimes that related to the profession.
 - The Assisted Living Administrator Regulations: It has been forwarded to the Executive Director, Associate Director and Interim Senior Deputy Director for signatures. It will then be forwarded to the General Counsel and DC Health Director.
 - The Home Health Administrator Regulations: This matter is still pending the establishment of subcommittee members.

CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

- B. Michelle Harris, Interim Board Chair, indicated that the Board needs additional Board members. There are currently only two (2) members on the Board. The Board does not have a nursing home administration.
- NAB 2022 Mid-Year Meeting will be held on November 2-4, 2022, in Palm Springs, California.

Examination Requirements:
Mr. Dallas Salisbury, Consumer Member, shared his views on the importance of requiring and implementing of the





examinations for the Assisted Living Administrator prior to processing the license.

- Subcommittee Requirements:
 - Mr. Salisbury also suggested to implement a regulation or policies/procedures to be used by the board/consumer members as guidance of the delegation process of subcommittees.
- AAG Gohil pointed out that the Board has the ultimate decision on the drafted regulation from the subcommittee. Some of the Board Members are also present at the subcommittee.
- Appointment of Interim Chair: Mr. Salisbury had a question regarding the decision on appointing of the interim chair for the Board. Ms. LaTrice Herndon, Executive Director, indicated that the decision is made by the Executive Director.
