#### **Legislative Updates**

On October 5, 2023, Dr. Ayanna Bennett's confirmation hearing took place. During the hearing, Dr. Bennett presented her vision and provided some perspective on the future direction of DC Health. Furthermore, on October 10, 2023, the Committee on Health convened to move Dr. Bennett's nomination out of the committee. Dr. Bennett's nomination is expected to be presented to the council for a vote at the next scheduled legislative meeting.

#### **Health Professional Compact Bills:**

 The Council is currently reviewing three distinct legislative agreements, pertaining to the professions of nursing, occupational therapy, and professional counseling.

#### **Board Confirmation Roundtable:**

On September 25, 2023, the Committee on Health organized a round table for several Board nominees, including those for the Physical Therapist, Board of Occupational Therapy, and Board of Medicine positions. Physical Therapy Board members Ana Quinones and Dr. Nicholas Caylor were present for renomination, and Dr. Worthy, a new Board nominee, attended as well. Currently, the Board members are awaiting their swearing-in ceremony.

## Health Professional Licensing Boards Residency Requirement Amendment Act of 2023:

 The Health Professional Residency Legislative did not pass as the vote was unanimous. However, this legislation will be up for a second reading in early October.

#### **HORA Revision**

 The HORA Revision is in its final review stage with the Executive Office of the Mayor. A date for the hearing is expected to be announced soon.
