Health Professional Licensing Boards Residency Requirement Amendment Act of 2023:
<ul> <li>Councilmembers Henderson and Parker introduced the Health Professional Licensing Boards Residency Requirement Amendment Act of 2023 (<u>B25-0312</u>) on June 2, 2023.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>This legislation would permit non-District residents to serve on health professional licensing boards.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>There would be restrictions, including that the Board Chair and Consumer Members would continue to need to be District residents and no more than 50% of the Board could be made up of non-District residents.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>This bill received a hearing on <u>July 13, 2023</u>. DC Health testified during this hearing and expressed support for the need for innovative solutions to fill board vacancies and offered some changes to the bill. It will likely receive a markup in September.</li> </ul>
