	Background: Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Mayor issued an Administrative Order that waived licensure requirements and for the allowance of telehealth. The Office of Health Professional Licensing would like all the Boards to look at drafting regulations to address the role telehealth will play in the District post COVID-19.	
	During the April meeting, the Board discussed the ramifications of tele-practice in social work. The Board requested that the attorney draft a tele-practice policy for the Board of Social Work that could possibly be implemented into the regulations.	
	The Board discussed the matter and draft policy submitted and decided to research more and submit additional comments to the Attorney so the draft policy can be amended for review at the next Board meeting.

	Board Action: To provide feedback regarding core questions related to the profession.	
	Background:	
	The Health Regulation and Licensing Administration plans to incorporate workforce surveys during renewals for all professions. The Workforce Survey is used to capture the distribution of healthcare providers across the District and obtain feedback regarding hot topics related to your profession.
