	Dr. DelVento stated that our arbovirus program has been going on well and is expected to continue until October, depending on the temperature and mosquito population.	
	Dr. Sarah Sirica reported 27 cases of arbovirus in crows, there were a couple of cases from Maryland as well. There is a rise in rodenticide cases and City Wildlife had been tracking data to find out the point of origin in DC, but these cases are spread all across the District. They are also examining if there is any particular type of rodenticide responsible for this but this test is expensive and costs \$80 per sample.

Mr. Matteo Lieb provided the following updates.

DC Health Director Appointment:

 On June 8th, Mayor Bowser <u>announced</u> the appointment of Dr. Ayanna Bennett as DC Health Acting Director.





- Dr. Bennett is a healthcare and public health executive with more than 20 years of experience in clinical practice, clinical service design, system integration, and quality improvement.
 Dr. Bennett most recently served as Chief Health Equity
 Officer and Director of the San Francisco Department of Public Health's Office of Health Equity.
- The Committee on Health held a confirmation hearing on October 5th. The committee heard from Dr. Bennett as she detailed her experience and expressed her eagerness and excitement to get to work. Witnesses testified in support of the new director, addressing issues they'd like the Director to work/focus on.

Board Confirmation Roundtable:

- The Committee on Health hosted a <u>roundtable</u> on September 25th to discuss the nominees to the Board of Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, and Medicine.
 - Those nominees are Rayan Hagona-Wordie, Nicholas Caylor, and Ana Quiñones, to the Boards of Physical Therapy; Charles Bond to the Board of Occupational Therapy; and Dr. Carolyn Gorman, Daanish Jones, and Dr. Padmaja Pavuluri to the Board of Medicine.
- OGR anticipates that the Committee on Health will host more meetings like these ones to discuss health professional board nominations.

Opioid and Fentanyl Epidemic Resolution of 2023

Councilmember Christina Henderson, Chair of the Committee on Health, announced a public roundtable, the <u>"Sense of the Council on the Opioid and Fentanyl Epidemic Resolution of 2023."</u> The roundtable will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, October 26, 2023. This Sense of the Council urges the Mayor to declare the opioid and fentanyl crisis in the District of Columbia a public health emergency, in recognition of the severity of the situation and the need to commit sufficient resources to safeguard the well-being of District residents.

Health Occupations Revision Act (HORA) Update:

- DC Health worked on a significant revision of the HORA. This would be the first significant revision in seventeen years. The members of each board shall not be required to be residents of the District at the time of their appointments and while they are members of the board.
- The revised HORA is currently going through Mayoral approval.

The new Veterinary Technician and Euthanasia Technicians regulations became effective Friday, August 6, 2021. At this time, the DC Department of Health will not be issuing registrations until the process is in place.

The Department of Health is currently creating the platform by which individuals can submit an application for registration as either a Veterinary Technician or a Veterinary Euthanasia Technician. Once the platform is available, there will be a grace period for which individuals will need to come into full compliance.
