The Animal Health Fair and the Free Pet Vaccine Clinic started in September and will continue until the first week of November. The Humane Rescue Alliance (HRA) in collaboration with DC Health has been providing free rabies and distemper vaccines to the District residents. The program was well-received by the residents. DC Health staff has also been facilitating

	The new Veterinary Technician and Euthanasia Technicians regulations became effective Friday, August 6, 2021. At this time, the DC Department of Health will not be issuing registrations until the process is in place.  The Department of Health is currently creating the platform by which individuals can submit an application for registration as either a Veterinary Technician or a Veterinary Euthanasia Technician. Once the platform is available, there will be a grace period for which individuals will need to come into full compliance.
