Ebola Outbreak

Dr. DelVento reports the outbreak of Ebola. There is no specific concern related to the District. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recently reported confirmed cases of Ebola virus disease (EVD) in the Uganda caused by the Sudan virus (species Sudan ebolavirus). No suspected, probable, or confirmed cases related to this outbreak have been reported in the United States or the District of Columbia.

Dr. Vito DelVento reports the recent launch of the online dog licensing portal that can be utilized to submit New and Renewal Dog License Applications as well as Replacement Dog Tag Applications, Hobby Permits, Potentially Dangerous and Dangerous Dog Applications, Chicken in the School Applications and Special Event Permit Applications. Dr. DelVento reports that our rabies surveillance continues as it always does. Our 2022 arbovirus surveillance program has come to an end now and we are in the process of putting arbovirus data in the national database.

There is going to be less animal related activity in winter months.

With regards to Avian influenza, Dr. Vito DelVento reports that the first case of Avian influenza was confirmed by the National Zoo in October.

The cause of death of the bird was blunt trauma and upon necropsy Avian Influenza detected as an incidental finding.

Dr. Dan Teich reports that leptospirosis is back in the District, and it was recently reported by the Friendship Animal Hospital. A daycare center also reported a leptospirosis case. Dr. Teich further added that leptospirosis vaccine should be considered a core vaccination because there's an uptick in the number of positive cases this year.
