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	Dr. Vito DelVento reports on behalf of Dr. Sharon Lewis. She extends a Thank You to The Board of Veterinary Medicine for their continues efforts and	
	commitment. She wishes everybody happy holidays.	
	Dr. Lewis forwarded a message for folks who have requested an exemption	
	of the Covid19 vaccination mandate that their requests have been under	
	review. Thee review process has been taking longer than expected but the effort is ongoing.	
	Please note that there are three options for vaccine exemptions.	
	1) Medical Exemption: If there's any medical conditions that prevents an individual to get vaccinated, he/she will be exempt. A doctor's note is	
	required.	
	2) Religious Exemption: If a religious belief prohibits someone from getting vaccinated, a personal statement is required in this case in order to get an exemption.	
	3) WHO Exemption: If an individual has received a vaccine outside of the	
	U.S., which is not approved by FDA but approved by the World Health	
	Organization, that individual will be exempt from vaccine requirements in the U.S.

	Frank Meyers reports that December 17, 2021 is going to be his last day with the Department of Health. He has accepted a position with another organization.	
	He further reports that licensure waiver was extended by legislation until	
	August 2022. The licensure waiver allows individuals to practice in the	
	District — who are licensed in other states and their license is in good	
	standing — if they are doing so at a District licensed healthcare facility or providing continuity of care to already established patients via telehealth.	
	DC Health staff members have been continuing to report at work. It's a	
	hybrid work environment these days — staff members work in the office most days a week.

Our arbovirus surveillance program has come to an end in October, and we are in the process of summarizing the data and entering it into the national data bank. A couple of facilities are left for inspection and we hope to complete their inspection by the end of this year. There are quite a few animal related events going to take place in the District during the holiday season. These events need animal specialty permits.

	Ed Rich reports that a statute regarding the standard of care regulations that the council passed a few years ago has been finally signed off and these regulations will be published on this Friday's register (December 17, 2021). These regulations will establish civil infractions for violation of the animal control laws and abusive treatment of certain pets. The Humane Rescue Alliance will now be able to issue tickets for these violations and for not complying with laws related to dangerous and potentially dangerous dogs. Ed Rich further reports that if healthcare professionals including veterinarians are not fully vaccinated, their licenses will not be renewed.

<u>Veterinarian, Veterinarian Technician, Veterinarian Euthanasia Technician</u> <u>Regulations</u>

The new Veterinary Technician and Euthanasia Technicians regulations became effective Friday, August 6, 2021. At this time, the DC Department of Health will not be issuing registrations until the process is in place.

The Department of Health is currently creating the platform by which individuals can submit an application for registration as either a Veterinary Technician or a Veterinary Euthanasia Technician. Once the platform is available, there will be a grace period for which individuals will need to come into full compliance.
