## **LEGISLATIVE/REGULATIONS**

## <u>PDMP</u>

Mr. Matteo Lieb provided the following insights:

## **Performance and Budget Oversight:**

- The Committee on Health hosted DC Health's Performance Oversight hearing on Thursday March 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- During her testimony, Interim Director Dr. Lewis discussed the role
  of equity in DC Health's work, DC Health's IT modernizations efforts,
  DC Health's response to the mpox outbreak, healthcare workforce
  development and licensure, and DC Health's strategic planning
  process.

- DC Health's Budget Oversight hearing is scheduled for April 10<sup>th</sup> (public witnesses) and April 12<sup>th</sup> (DC Health representatives).
   The Committee of the Whole will host a budget briefing on March 24<sup>th</sup> to review the Mayor's proposed budget.

#### **Health Licensing Board Oversight**

- The Committee on Health hosted a Performance Oversight hearing for five of DC Health's Health Professional Licensing Boards.
  - These are the Boards of Medicine, Nursing, Pharmacy, Psychology, and Social Work.
- The hearing took place virtually on February 28<sup>th</sup>. It focused on topics including workforce shortages, board membership, and education and training. You can watch the hearing at the following <u>link</u>.

## **Congressional Review:**

- DC Health continues to monitor legislation undergoing Congressional Review
- The U.S. House of Representatives and the Senate approved a resolution of disapproval for the Revised Criminal Code Act of 2021 (B24-0416)
  - o This occurred for the first time in 30 years
- DC Health does not anticipate any concerns with Congressional Review for any public health related pieces of legislation.

## <u>Veterinarian, Veterinarian Technician, Veterinarian Euthanasia Technician</u> Regulations

The new Veterinary Technician and Euthanasia Technicians regulations became effective Friday, August 6, 2021. At this time, the DC Department of Health will not be issuing registrations until the process is in place.

The Department of Health is currently creating the platform by which individuals can submit an application for registration as either a Veterinary Technician or a Veterinary Euthanasia Technician. Once the platform is available, there will be a grace period for which individuals will need to come into full compliance.
