OS-0415-07	<p><b><u>ASSOCIATE DIRECTOR’S REPORT:</u></b></p> <p>Frank Meyers reported that we are currently working on the roll out of our new online licensure system, which will allow us to take application via our online web portal. This will streamline the application process for licensing professional.</p> <p>Dr. DelVento also wanted to report that the new online platform will also service dog licensure later. This will also benefit our residence a great deal to get their animals licensed efficiently.</p>

The Veterinarian regulations, The Veterinary Tech regulation, and Vet Euthanasia Tech regulations were all accepted for publication at DC Register. The regulation will go out for 3<sup>rd</sup> proposed rulemaking. All 3 sets of regulation where approved by the council division, mayor of general council, and the Department of Policy and Legislative affairs.</p> <p>All 3 sets of regulation will be out for 30-day comment. Assuming nothing major comes back the regulation will be able to be published as final.</p> <p>There was a 4<sup>th</sup> set of regulations sent to the Mayor's office of policy and legislative affairs those regulations deal with the implementation of the standard of care for animal's act which was passed by DC Council a couple of years ago. These regulations are moving forward and will be published for rule making sometime soon.</p>
