- Ms. Williams gave an update on the following: Chairperson Carolyn Williams has been selected again to host the 2023 American Association for Respiratory Care (AARC)/ American Respiratory Care Foundation (ARCF) International Fellowship Program and would like to invite Dr. Iyana Bennett, Appointed Acting Director for DC Health, Senior Deputy Director, Arian Gibson, Executive Director, Ericka Walker, and Board of Respiratory Care staff to meet with Dr. Volodymr Suskyi, Anesthesiologist from Ukriane and Moaaz Essam, Respiratory Therapist from Egypt during their visit to Washington, DC on October 22 – 29, 2023. Dr. Suskyi and Moaaz Essam will have the opportunity to observe Respiratory Care Practitioners at Children's Hospital, and Medstar Georgetown University Hospital. Board Member Betty Akpan will host them at Medstar Washington Hospital Center, Board Member Carla Seals will host them at Bridgepoint Hospital, and they will also go to the University of District of Columbia to visit the Respiratory Therapy staff and students.
- Chairperson Carolyn Williams forwarded Health Licensing Specialist, Zaneta Batts via email regarding AARC received a grant from the Department of Defense to support development of an Interstate Compact for the Respiratory Therapy Profession.
- Maryland/DC Society for Respiratory Care Conference by the Sea is scheduled for September 13-15, 2023, in Ocean City, Maryland. Respiratory Care Practitioners can receive up to 16 continuing education credits, to include Ethics, Public Health, and LGBTQ courses. The conference tracker app will be utilized to record individuals' certificate of attendance, courses taken, and allow every therapist registered to log in and print out their own continuing education credits without the organization sending it to them.
