
Do You Know an Adolescent who Needs Help with a Substance Abuse Problem?

There are three steps to access adolescent substance abuse treatment in the District:



STEP 1 → Review the list of participating ASTEP Providers.

STEP 2 \rightarrow Schedule an appointment. Many ASTEP providers accept walk-ins or make same-day appointments.

STEP 3 \rightarrow Receive a comprehensive substance abuse assessment and discuss treatment options with a caring treatment professional.
