Dear Sr. Alphonse Marie Jones:

On March 26, 2018, a Life Safety Code survey was completed at your facility by surveyors from the Department of Health (DOH), Health Regulation and Licensing Administration, to determine if your facility was in compliance with federal requirements for nursing homes participating in the Medicare and Medicaid programs. This survey found that your facility was not in substantial compliance with the participation requirements.

This survey found the most serious deficiency reflects no harm with potential for more than minimal harm (i.e. Level D).

A plan of correction (POC) for the deficiencies was received on April 5, 2018, with alleged compliance date of April 4, 2018. Based on a review of the aforementioned document, your POC and allegation of compliance have been accepted.
