DISCUSSION ITEMS

OS-0320-08 LEGISLATIVE UPDATES - OFFICE OF GOVERNMENT RELATIONS

Mr. Matteo Lieb, DC Health's Legislative Affairs Specialist, to provide updates on the following:

Health Occupations Revision Act (HORA) Update:

- DC Health worked on a significant revision of the HORA. This would be the first significant revision in seventeen years.
- The revised HORA received Mayoral approval and has been introduced in the Council as the *Health Occupations Revision General Amendment Act of 2023* (B25-0545).
- This legislation received a hearing on <u>December 7th</u>. Over 80 witnesses, many
 of whom were healthcare professionals, signed up to provide testimony. DC
 Health's Associate Director of Health Professional Licensing Boards provided
 testimony in support and answered questions from the Council.
- DC Health has been working on the Committee on Health following that hearing. A mark-up has been scheduled for March 21st, 2024.

Health Professional Licensing Boards Residency Requirement Amendment Act of 2023:

- Councilmembers Henderson and Parker introduced the *Health Professional Licensing Boards Residency Requirement Amendment Act of 2023* (B25-0312) on June 2, 2023.
 - This legislation would permit non-District residents to serve on health professional licensing boards.
 - There would be restrictions, including that the Board Chair and Consumer Members would continue to need to be District residents and no more than 50% of the Board could be made up of non-District residents.
- This bill received a hearing on <u>July 13, 2023</u>. DC Health testified during this
 hearing and expressed support for the need for innovative solutions to fill board
 vacancies and offered some changes to the bill. It then passed on final reading





on November 7th, was signed by the Mayor on November 21st, and became official law on January 23, 2024.

DC Health FY 23 Performance Oversight Hearing

- DC Health recently had its performance oversight hearing in the Committee on Health for Fiscal Year 2023.
- The first part of the hearing was held on January 18th, 2024. That hearing featured public witnesses and included representatives from advocacy organizations, healthcare systems, and non-profit providers. That hearing can be watched at the following link.
- Representatives from DC Health then testified to the Committee on January 22nd, 2024. Testimony was provided by Director Bennett and other members of leadership and subject matter experts. Councilmembers asked questions of DC Health on a variety of topics including health professional licensing, DC Health's upcoming move, maternal health, food access, opioid abatement, and school health. DC Health Fiscal Year 2025 Budget Oversight

- DC Health will have its Fiscal Year 2025 Budget Oversight hearing in early April. This hearing offers an opportunity for the Committee on Health to review DC Health's proposed budget for the 2025 Fiscal Year.
- There will be two hearings, one on April 1st for public witnesses and one on April 4th for representatives from DC Health.

OS-0320-10 "TELEDENTISTRY" QUESTIONS REGARDING RULES AND STATUTES

Ms. Carla Willams explained the process the "emailer" is proposing that a DC licensed dental hygienist will gather the patient records, the DC licensed dentist will remotely examine the records, the dental hygienist would provide services onsite and all other treatment would be referred to a local dentist. The scope of services provided by the hygienist would be limited to those allowed under general supervision under the practice act. There would also be cameras and other equipment available to enable real-time synchronous encounter between the dentist and the patient.

Dr. John Bailey commented that the request is different from what is published in the DC statutes as the treating/consulting dentist would have to be within the District of Columbia and not in another state. Also the hygienist performing the exam with the





dentist supervising via telephone conference is not the same as the dentist being present to watch over the patient and sign off if any issues arise.

Dr. Iris Jeffries-Morton inquired if the District of Columbia currently has any regulations published about teledentistry specifically? Dr. John Bailey answered it has been discussed but not to the point of being ready to create regulations. Ms. Carla Williams agreed and added there are provisions in the HORA draft bill that is currently before the council that will speak to "telehealth" as a whole. From there, the regulations will be built.

Mrs. Brittany Harris-Campbell added that it is also important to clarify dental services and preventative services for the future so people are aware in terms of Teledentisty and performing dental hygiene at a distance.

Ms. Carla Williams will draft a formal response advising what is being asked is that it is not permissible under our current law as we do not have the regulations to govern it.

OS-0320-11 ANONYMOUS QUESTION

The Board has received an inquiry from a Dental Hygienist Licensee regarding the possible usage of an LLC for compensation. The Dental Hygienist would like to start and use an LLC to be compensated for any services they provide as a temp hygienist. The hygienist states they normally receive a 1099 at the end of each tax year. However, due to not being classified as a W-2 employee, they usually owe a large sum of money at the end of every tax year. They hope to take advantage of the tax benefits of being an independent contractor.

The Board agreed that this dental hygienist would not be in violation of any of the District's laws or regulations governing the practice of dental hygiene.

OS-0320-12 COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

Sarah Hoverter asked (to Mr. Mateo Lieb) if the committee print will be available before the mark-up tomorrow or not. **Mr. Lieb** answered more than likely it will not be available before the mark-up but he recommends she reach out to the to Ashley Strange on the Committee on Health to get an accurate answer (her email was provided in chat).

Ms. Fatima Oglesby-Morris asked in regard to the Dental Assistant Level III registration, will applicants have to take Continuing Education credits to learn the extra duties (like placing sealants and glucose testing)? **Ms. Carla Williams** answered that the regulations include the requirements as well as the additional coursework that has to be completed in order to qualify for a Level III registration. The regulations can be found on the website and are available in the DC register.

Mr. Kurt Gallagher asked looking at regulations, one requirement is applicants need to successfully pass a board approved hands-on course. Is there a list provided by the board and would that list include any courses offered by DANB (Dental Assistant National Board) for the Level III registration. **Ms. Carla Williams** answered the DANB course that is required is stated in the regulations.
