Dear DC PDMP User:

DC Health is pleased to announce a Districtwide initiative to integrate District of Columbia Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (DC PDMP) data into the Electronic Health Records and Pharmacy Management systems in DC, using Appriss Health's PMP Gateway service. The integration will eliminate the need for providers to navigate to the DC PDMP website, log-in, and enter their patient's information. Instead, the EHR will automatically initiate a patient query, which will return the patient's prescription records directly within the clinical workflow inside the EHR.
