NATIONAL CERTIFICATION BOARD FOR THERAPEUTIC MASSAGE & BODYWORK (NCBTMB)

Board Action:

Review of the information from NCBTMB regarding the two (2) examinations and determine if they will be accepted by the District.

Background:

The current Massage Therapy regulations only reference the acceptance of a National Certification Examination for Therapeutic Massage and Bodywork (NCETMB) exam. The national exam section of the regulations hasn't been updated since the National Certification Examination for Therapeutic Massage (NCETM) was developed.

The NCBTMB has two (2) recognized national examinations (NCETMB and NCETM). Both exams have similar questions, but NCETMB had some eastern modality questions, where NCETM was completely western based. NCBTMB initially developed the NCETMB and then sometime around 2007 or 2009 the NCETM exam was developed.





NCETM is another exam option for massage therapist to take as their national exam. There are twenty-seven (27) states that accept either exams as a national exam. (Among those states are our neighboring jurisdictions, Maryland and Virginia.) Kanas is also in the process of accepting both exams.

Motion:

Board voted to accept both examinations from NCBTMB by consensus.
