	<p><u>Background:</u></p> <p>The current regulation under section 7706 indicates the waiver of examination and educational requirements for licensure. Certain applicants who have been licensed in other jurisdictions for a longer duration. For example, over 10 years, and have the required practical experience most often are required to take the AMFTRB National Exams prior to licensure by endorsement in DC. Some states do have the examination waiver requirements for applicants applying by reciprocity provided they might have taken a state exam (example: California State Exams) which might be comparable to the National Exams. The Board to review section 7706 of the current regulations to identify if the requirements could be streamlined to facilitate the administrative, review, and approval process of applicants who fall under this category.</p>
