The Rat Riddance Rodent and Vector Control Academy is designed to enhance the teachings of **Intergraded Pest Management (IPM)** as an important foundation for a successful municipal rodent control plan. In addition, the program continues to encourage partnerships between District of Columbia and federal agencies, as well as with public and private partners in the community, all working together to reduce rodent activity and to minimize health risks from rodents for residents and visitors of the District.

The Rat Riddance Rodent and Vector Control Academy will provide participants with **classroom exercises**. The academy will have presenters from DC Department of Energy and Environment, Department of Public Works, and Univar Environmental Sciences.
