### D. OFFICE OF GOVERNMENT RELATION'S REPORT

- i. The Office of Government Relations provided an update on the Health Licensing Board Residency Requirement Amendment Act of 2023.
- ii. Councilmembers Henderson and Parker introduced the Health Professional Licensing Boards Residency Requirement Amendment Act of 2023 (<u>B25-0312</u>) on June 2, 2023.
  - a. This legislation would permit non-District residents to serve on health professional licensing boards.
  - b. There would be restrictions, including that the Board Chair and Consumer Members would continue to need to be District residents and no more than 50% of the Board could be made up of non-District residents.
- iii. The Office of Government Relations provided an update on the DC Health Director Appointment. On June 8<sup>th</sup>, Mayor Bowser <u>announced</u> the appointment of Dr. Ayanna Bennett as DC Health Acting Director.
  - a. Dr. Bennett is a healthcare and public health executive with more than 20 years of experience in clinical practice, clinical service design, system integration, and quality improvement. Dr. Bennett most recently served as Chief Health Equity Officer and Director of the San Francisco Department of Public Health's Office of Health Equity.
  - b. The Council will hold a hearing on the Director of the Department of Health Dr.

    Ayanna Bennett Confirmation Resolution of 2023 (PR25-0290). The Committee on Health will hold a hearing on October 5<sup>th</sup> at 10AM to hear from the Director.
- iv. The Office of Government Relations provided an update on the Board Confirmation Roundtable. The Committee on Health hosted a <u>roundtable</u> on Wednesday May 31<sup>st</sup> to discuss two nominations to the Board of Massage Therapy.
  - a. Those nominees are Johanna Brooks and Maisha Goss-Johns
  - b. Johanna Brooks already serves on the Board, but Maisha Goss-Johns would be a new board member
