S 000	Initial Comments An annual inspection was conducted on February 22, 2010, through February 24, 2010. The survey findings were based on record review and staff interviews. The sample sizes were seventeen (17) employee records based on a census of seventeen (17), twenty five(25) adoptive parent record based on a census of twenty five (25), fifteen (15) domestic adoption records based on a census of fifteen (15), three (3) international adoption records based on a census of three (3), and three (3) post adoption records based on a census of three (3), and one (1) foster parent record based on a census of one (1). The agency was found to be in substantial compliance with Title 29 Chapter 16, Standards of Placement, Care, and Services for Child Placing however deficiencies were cited. S 103	We have reviewed the findings of the inspection and noted that adoptive parent #22 did, in fact, have a current physical exam. The original home study, approved on January 29, 2008, documented the findings of a September 14, 2007 physical exam and the home study update, approved on March 12, 2009, documented the findings of a December 19, 2008 physical exam. All of these items were contained in the case file at the time of the licensing inspection. The home study template used to guide the work of the home study social workers and program directors has been updated to include a reminder that the physical exam must have been completed within six months of the study	March 19, 2010
