

# COLORECTAL Cancer

Colorectal cancer is the 4th most commonly diagnosed cancer and 4th leading cause of cancer death in the District of Columbia. (2016)\*

**#4** most commonly diagnosed cancer in the District (35.6 per 100,000 individuals).\*

**#4** leading cause of cancer deaths in the District (15.8 per 100,000 individuals).\*




**African Americans** in the District have an **incidence** rate that is two times higher than Whites.




**African Americans** in the District have a **mortality** rate that is two times higher than Whites.


Incidence rates have **decreased** in the District since 2012.
