African Americans have a 41% higher incidence rate than Whites in 2018.



African Americans have almost **4 times** the **mortality** rate of Whites in 2018.



As of December 2018, the five-year colorectal cancer **survival rate** was **15%** higher for **Whites** than for African-Americans (64% vs 55%).

Incidence rates have increased following an initial decline **and mortality rates** have **declined** since 2014 in the District.


Age-adjusted incidence rates of colorectal cancer in DC vs US, 2014-2018
