
Over this time period, breast cancer incidence was similar for African American women and White women.





Over this time period, breast cancer mortality was almost **2x** higher for **African American** women compared to White women.



For diagnosis years 2011-2018, the 5 year breast cancer **survival rate** was higher for **White** women than for African-American women.








Breast cancer incidence declined about 1.7% per year.
