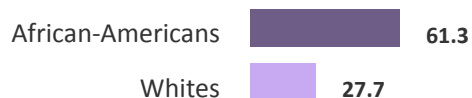

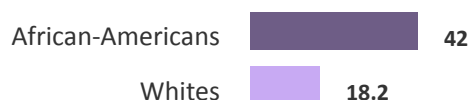

Over this period, lung cancer incidence was **2x** higher for **African American** women compared to White women.



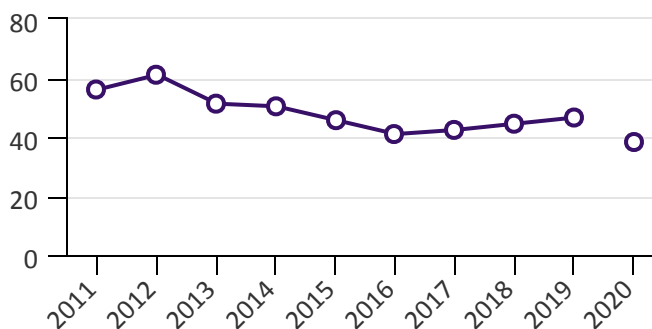
Over this period, lung cancer mortality was **2x** higher for **African American** women compared to White women



For diagnosis years 2011-2018, the 5 year lung cancer **survival rate** for African-Americans was 24.8%.

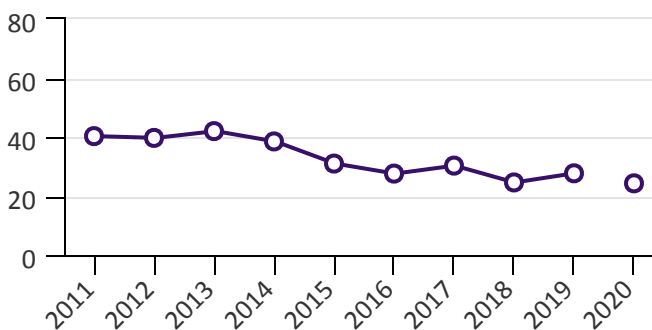


Age-adjusted incidence, 2011 to 2020\*



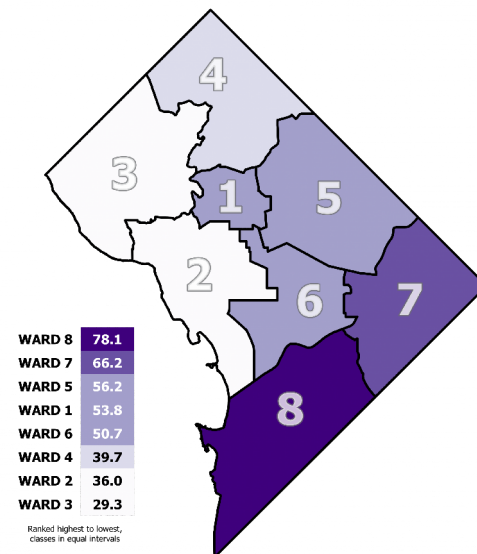
Lung cancer incidence declined about 4.0 % per year.
