Checklist of Requirements for Pharmacy Technician License:

To ensure prompt processing of your NEW LICENSE APPLICATION be sure to submit all supporting documents listed below.

- ☐ Completed online application for licensure.
- ☐ One (1) recent passport size photo (2" X 2")
- A Social Security Number or a sworn affidavit <u>and</u> proof that the applicant is legally authorized to work in the United States.
- Name change documents (Marriage Certificate, Divorce Decree or Court Order).
- ☐ One (1) clear photocopy of a US Government-issued photo ID, such as a driver's license, or US passport photo page as proof of identity (applicant must be at least 17 years old).
- A Criminal Background Check
- An official high school or college transcript, or a GED certificate directly from the institution of higher learning recognized by an accrediting body approved by the Secretary of the United States Department of Education.
- Clear copy of current Pharmacy Technician Certificate from one of the following:
 - The Pharmacy Technician Certification Board (PTCB)
 - The National Health Career Association (formerly ICPT)
 - o A Board-approved pharmacy technician training program
 - Another state certifying organization approved by the Board.
- An application fee of \$50.00 (fees are non-refundable).

<u>Checklist of Requirements for Pharmacy Technician Registration Obtained</u> <u>by Reciprocity</u>:

To ensure prompt processing of your NEW LICENSE APPLICATION be sure to submit all supporting documents listed below.

- A completed online application for licensure.
- \Box One (1) recent passport size photo (2" X 2")
- A Social Security Number OR a Sworn Affidavit <u>and</u> proof that the applicant is legally authorized to work in the United States.
- Name Change Documents (Marriage Certificate, Divorce Decree or Court Order).
- ☐ One (1) clear photocopy of a US Government-issued photo ID, such as a driver's license, or US passport photo page as proof of identity (applicant must be at least 17 years old).
- A Criminal Background Check
- Proof of current licensure, registration, or certification, in good standing to practice as a pharmacy technician in another state. (Copy of Pharmacy Technician License)
- Official Verification from each state in which the applicant holds or has ever held a pharmacy technician registration, that the registration is <u>current and in good standing</u>, or if the registration is no longer active, that it was in <u>good standing</u> immediately prior to its expiration. The registration verification form must be sent directly to the Board, by the verifying Board.
- An application fee of \$50.00 (fees are non-refundable).

Checklist of Requirements for Pharmacy Technician Trainee Registration:

To ensure prompt processing of your NEW LICENSE APPLICATION be sure to submit all supporting documents listed below.

- A completed online application for licensure.
- \Box One (1) recent passport size photo (2" X 2")
- A Social Security Number or a sworn affidavit <u>and</u> proof that the applicant is legally authorized to work in the United States.
- Name change documents (Marriage Certificate, Divorce Decree or Court Order).
- ☐ One (1) clear photocopy of a US Government- issued photo ID, such as a driver's license or US passport photo page as proof of identity (applicant must be at least 17 years old).
- A Criminal Background Check.
- An official high school or college transcript, or a GED certificate in a sealed envelope directly from an institution of higher learning recognized by an accrediting body approved by the Secretary of the United States Department of Education).
- Proof of enrollment in a Board-approved pharmacy technician training program.
- An official letter from Pharmacist/Training Program Manager showing that the Pharmacy Technician Trainee shall perform duties that commensurate with the training and experience he/she received.
