- Dogs must be secured on a leash and cats must be secured in a carrier.
- All pets must be brought to the clinic by a responsible adult.
- Dogs over the age of four (4) months old are required by law to be vaccinated against rabies and distemper. Cats over the age of four (4) months old are required to be vaccinated against rabies and feline distemper. Only these vaccines are available at the clinics.
- The law requires that all dogs are licensed with the District – these will be available to purchase at the clinic.
- Dog license is \$15 for a spayed or neutered dog and \$50 for an unspayed or unneutered dog.
- If available, please bring previous vaccination history.
- No feral or semi-feral pets (animals living in the community without an owner).
